## **Purpose of the meeting**

Welcome to the public information meeting for the WIS 66 improvement project, between WIS 34 (town of Rudolph) and West Gate Drive (town of Linwood) in Wood and Portage counties.

The purpose of the meeting is to present the most current information, answer questions and listen to your comments, concerns or suggestions. The meeting will follow an open house format. No formal presentations are scheduled.

## **Project information**

The 12.5 mile section of WIS 66 will be resurfaced. Improvements also include the replacement of Mosquito and Alder Creek bridges in Wood County, Skelly and Mill Creek bridges in Portage County, and the installation of 35 culvert pipe liners.

## **Traffic impacts**

Construction is scheduled to begin in late August 2011. Work is scheduled for completion in late October 2012.

During construction in 2011, WIS 66 will remain open to traffic. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during daylight hours via flagging operations.

During construction in 2012, WIS 66 will be closed and detoured via WIS 34, Old US 10, and Portage County HH (Old US 10). WIS 66 will be closed to traffic at the bridge replacement locations. Local access will be maintained.

## **Project update**

WisDOT conducted a meeting with local officials on November 11, 2010. During the meeting, attendees suggested that we schedule the 2012 detour of WIS 66 for the bridge replacements after the spring school semester ends in June 2012. The WIS 66 detour is currently scheduled to begin around June 12 and will conclude in late October 2012.

## **Other ongoing projects**

The US 10 improvements between Portage County N and Long Road will require a detour of WIS 34 between existing US 10 and WIS 66. Traffic will be detoured via WIS 66, Wood/Portage County O, and existing US 10.

This detour is expected to be in place from April to mid October 2011.
